**Tuesday, 03/13** John 1: 35 - 42

- John introduces Jesus to his disciples as the Lamb of God. Would you follow a leader characterized as a sacrificial lamb?

**Wednesday, 03/14:** Revelation 5: 5 - 14

- Revelation describes Jesus as both lion and lamb. How do you harmonize these two opposing images?

**Thursday, 03/15:** Exodus 12: 1 - 4

- What does the Passover celebration mean for Christians?

**Friday, 03/16:** Isaiah 53: 1 - 6

- What infirmities of yours has He borne?

**Saturday, 03/17:** Isaiah 53: 7 - 9
