Monday, 04/03: Luke 19: 11 - 27

- Jesus tells an intense parable about a nobleman, his servants, and some hateful citizens to illustrate the coming kingdom of God. What do you think is the primary lesson of this story?

Tuesday, 04/04: Luke 20: 1 - 8

- The chief priests, scribes, and elders question Jesus' authority while he is teaching in the temple. What do you make of the way Jesus responded to their questions?

Wednesday, 04/05: Luke 20: 9 - 19

- Jesus tells a parable about a vineyard against the scribes and chief priests. What does this story teach us about the owner of the vineyard?

Thursday, 04/06: Luke 20: 20 - 26

- Questioners attempt to trap Jesus with questions about taxes to Caesar, but he outwits them and evades their traps. How would you honestly describe your relationship with money?

Friday, 04/07: Luke 20: 27 - 40

- The Sadducees attempt to trap Jesus in a question concerning the Resurrection. He outwits them. How do your thoughts on "heaven" compare with Jesus' statement?

Saturday, 04/08: Luke 21: 1 - 4

- The story of the widow's offering is well known. How do you view your offering to the Lord? Do you give out of your abundance or out of your left-overs?
