Monday, 04/17: Romans 5: 12 - 21

- Grace is a gift given for all through the sacrifice and resurrection of Christ. Offer a gift to someone today: perhaps a grocery gift card to someone in need, a cup of coffee behind you in line, or time with someone who needs a listening ear.

Tuesday, 04/18: Romans 6: 1 - 11

- The gift of Christ, through our baptism, means death does not rule. Remember your baptism today. You are loved, forgiven, and called to share the good news!

Wednesday, 04/19: 1 Corinthians 11: 23 - 26

- Here we recall Jesus' words during the Last Supper with the apostles. As you break bread (eat your meals) today, remember the gift of God's nourishment and love.

Thursday, 04/20: 1 Corinthians 15: 1 - 11

- The Apostle Paul recounts the resurrection of Jesus, emphasizing that the first witnesses are now dead. How can you share the Good News of Jesus 2,000 years later?

Friday, 04/21: Hebrews 1: 1 - 4

- Jesus is put into context of God's promises throughout history. Notice in the passage what God has done through Christ.

Saturday, 04/22: Hebrews 10: 1 - 10

- Jesus has offered us life and salvation, once and for all. God does not desire our own offering or sacrifices. How might this knowledge change your life of faith?
