- Jesus teaches about the kingdom of God and salvation. Can you think of good things in your own life that came from seemingly small or insignificant beginnings?

Wednesday, 03/15: Observing the Sabbath

Luke 14: 1 - 6

- The debate about observing the Sabbath continues. How are you finding Sabbath rest in your life?

Thursday, 03/16: Humility and Hospitality

Luke 14: 7 - 14

- Jesus gives guidance about a life of humility. Is humility a trait that others would use to describe you?

Friday, 03/17: Parable of the Great Dinner

Luke 14: 15 - 24

- What excuses do you hear (and use yourself) to avoid fully engaging in the kingdom work God has given you?

Saturday, 03/18: The Cost of Discipleship

Luke 14: 25 - 33

- Jesus responds to his growing popularity by warning that following him is neither comfortable nor easy. How does this make you feel?
