

About the Pin Design

The caring, supportive hands represent women who seek to build an inclusive community of Presbyterian Women. The leaf represents growth of our personal and corporate response to Jesus Christ as we nurture our faith. The dove indicates our work for peace in our own lives and throughout the world, shown in the globe. At the center of the design is the cross, by which our sins are forgiven and we are freed to live in Christ, who is the center of our lives. The overall design is of a butterfly, the symbol of newness in Christ.

EXCERPTS FROM CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN IN THE PRESBYTERY OF COASTAL CAROLINA (AMENDED APRIL 10, 2010) ARTICLE V DUTIES OF LEADERS

Section 1. The Moderator shall preside at all meetings of the CT and at all gatherings of PW in the congregation. She shall receive communications on behalf of the PW and be the direct link to PW in the Presbytery.

Section 2. The Vice-Moderator shall preside in the absence of the Moderator or at her request. If the office of the Moderator becomes vacant between elections, she shall complete the Moderator's term. She shall assist the Moderator as requested and shall be the special link between the CT and the Circles.

Section 4. The Recording Secretary shall maintain the working records of the organization and shall send communications as directed by the Moderator.

Section 6. The treasurer shall keep a record of receipts and disbursements of the funds of PW in the Congregation and shall forward to the Treasurer of PW in the Presbytery appropriate funds as directed by the CT in the Congregation.

Section 7. The Historian shall maintain and preserve the historical record of the Congregation.

Section 8. The Moderator of the Search Committee shall chair the Search Committee and present for election the names of women called to leadership positions to PW of the Congregation.

CELEBRATION OF MISSION THROUGH WOMEN'S PLEDGES

This is the source of our annual local budget. We ask that you support our work as you are able. You may contribute by check or cash at the General Meeting and Dinner (Sept) or first Circle Meeting (October); or you may give it at your Circle meetings, as you are able. We accept this as an "offering" at each Circle Meeting. So, you can contribute when and how you like. No one keeps a record. We only ask that you complete a pledge form at the General Meeting in September, to guide us in adjusting our budget if necessary.

SPECIAL OFFERINGS

THE THANK OFFERING (including Health Ministries) is given in the fall as a tangible expression of each PW's gratitude for the special blessings in her life and is used to support medical missions and projects selected by the Creative Ministries Offering Committee of PW.

THE BIRTHDAY OFFERING, in celebration of the Anniversary of Women of the Church PCUS, is taken in the spring and is used for predetermined projects also selected by the Creative Ministries Offering Committee of PW.

FELLOWSHIP OF THE LEAST COIN The International Fellowship of the Least Coin (IFLC) is a worldwide ecumenical movement of prayer for peace and reconciliation. Persons in this movement make a commitment to spend time in prayer, and to uphold in prayer others who are victims of jealousy, hatred, violence, and injustice to the family, community, nation, and the world. Every time one prays, she sets aside a "least coin" of her currency as a tangible token of her prayer. Church Women United is the custodian for FLC offerings in the United States. We accept his "collection" of "least" coins whenever you attend your Circle Meetings.

CCPW OPERATING PROCEDURES

Circle Representatives on the Coordinating Team shall bring their Circle needs and concerns to the CT and shall communicate the actions for the CT to the Circles.

The Coordinating Team shall:

- Conduct an annual review and evaluation of goals for the year just completed.
- Set goals and objectives for the new program year.
- Prepare an annual budget and authorize expenditures.
- Discover and utilize the gifts of members.
- Be responsible for an ongoing educational program for women based on their spiritual needs.
- Provide opportunities to support the mission of the PC (USA).
- Maintain a relationship with the Session.
- Maintain a relationship with PW in the Presbytery and the wider church.
- Maintain relationships with other women's groups in the congregation and in the community.
- Provide funding for second nursery assistant during the worship hour.
- Coordinate with Session Congregational Care Team to provide monthly Fellowship Luncheon, Joy Gift Lunch, Mission Lunch and Birthday Brunch.
- Maintain Church kitchen.
- Schedule work days as needed.
